Canteen Manager

Your Canteen Manager is integral to your club's finances, promotion of club image and in educating your members on appropriate hydration and nutrition factors.

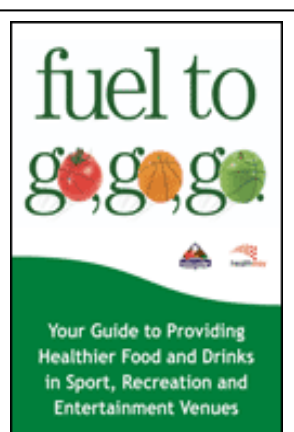
You must have a manager who co-ordinates all canteen volunteers in their specific roles and responsibilities and it is highly advisable that the Canteen Manager be trained in food handling, leading a team of volunteers, handling money, maintaining a stock inventory, ordering and storage of food and beverages and customer service.

A way to retain a quality Manager is to either pay them a wage or honorarium or allow them a percentage of profits.

A Canteen is the 'shop front' of your club – the way it is presented, the manner in which your customers are served and the quality of the products all contribute to the image of your club.

Food handlers need to remain separate from money handlers/servers. Canteen assistants need to be well groomed and demonstrate hygienic behaviours. There are several food handling practises which must be adhered to.
