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Smoking

Most Clubs promote health and well being. Some Clubs have an additional obligation through sponsorship to promote an anti smoking message.

All City of Armadale buildings are smoke free. Smoking is not permitted within 5 metres of doors and windows and 10 metres within air intake vents. Smoking is not permitted in thoroughfares and access paths.

- Smoking is not allowed in any indoor areas of the club (including the bar and change rooms).
- Functions held at your club could be promoted as smoke free.
- Designate some areas outdoors as smoke free or more preferably smoking only—this can be roped off.
- Do not sell cigarettes on your premises.
- Display appropriate 'no smoking' signage in your club.
- Ensure that senior members of your club role model and promote positive anti smoking behaviour.

Evidence of the harms caused by smoking and second-hand smoke continues to mount. And while smokers often feel frustrated by limitations on where and when they can smoke, most are accepting of these, respecting the rights of others around them to breathe clean air. *Australian Institute of Health and Welfare. 2004*
