Neighbours and Your Club

Your club is part of a community. Consideration for your neighbours is paramount, establishing a positive relationship with all of those around your club is necessary.

- Consider how your members leave from the club in their vehicles (vehicle noise, appropriate language, lights).
- Comply with your liquor licence and noise restriction regulations.
- Do not allow your members to go into or onto the property (to retrieve equipment) of a neighbour without their consent.
- Turn your floodlights out after use and no later than 9.00 pm.
- Remind your members of the use of appropriate language, on and off the field.
- Ensure that your clubrooms, surrounds and grounds are left in a tidy and respectable state.

Handy Hint

It is good PR to inform your neighbours when your club will be having a function on site. Provide them with fixtures of your home games.
