

## Accessing Grants

There are several useful sources from which to access grants. Most are for specific purposes and require applications which need to address specific criteria.

Generally you will need to:

- State your specific need for the grant.
- Articulate your club's role, structure and purpose.
- Acquit and/or write a report at the end of the project to validate the worth of the grant.
- Provide a statement of your club's financial position.

As a rule, grants and funding will not be made retrospectively.

The purpose of most grants is to increase participation, encourage the development of high performing athletes or to assist disadvantaged groups in becoming involved in sport.

Grants need to be for specific projects and will not be made for general maintenance or management of clubs or the payment of coaches, players or officials.
