

# **Growing Our Neighbourhoods – Community Barbeque Rebate**Guidelines and Information

### **Purpose**

Growing Our Neighbourhoods Community Barbeque Rebate program is designed to build trust and connection in communities across the City of Armadale. This will help to create a safer, connected healthier and friendly place for all. The purpose of the rebate is to support a gathering with your neighbours to work together to promote community safety and reduce social isolation.

## What you need to consider

- Who are you inviting?
- Get your neighbours involved because neighbours are more likely to attend if they are involved in planning.
- Invite everyone on the street or park.
- Event should be inclusive and accessible.
- Event must be hosted within the City of Armadale.

## What will you purchase with the funds?

The rebate is designed to support with the cost associated with the event, not cover it. Check with your neighbours to see if they can help by bringing something, this can be something they already have such as sauce or napkins or you could ask everyone to bring a plate.

### Who should apply?

- Residents within the City of Armadale.
- Streets that have little or no connection with their neighbours.
- If you have recently had new people move into the street.
- If you have recently moved to a new house and would like to meet your neighbours.
- One application per street per financial year.

## Register your event or activity

- Register your activity with the City of Armadale two weeks prior by completing the form on the City's website here.
- Host an alcohol-free event/activity
- Send in your receipts and apply for a rebate of up to \$100
