PROJECT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering a Submission for this project, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions.

Definitions

1. In these Terms and Conditions:
 - (a) "Project" means the Humans of Armadale 2025 - Community Volunteers Project;
 - (b) "Promoter" means the City of Armadale (ABN 79 863 269 538) of 7 Orchard Avenue, Armadale;

General

2. Submissions are open to Australian residents that meet the eligibility requirements in these terms and conditions.
3. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements form part of these terms and conditions.
4. By entering the promotion, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

Who Can Enter?

5. Entry to the Project is open to Australian residents who reside or volunteer in the City of Armadale, are 16 years of age or older, and who is not excluded by clause 6. Participants who are under 18 years of age must obtain consent from their parent or legal guardian to participate.
6. Elected members, managers, employees, and their immediate families, of the Promoter are not eligible to enter. For the purpose of this clause 'immediate family' means spouse, de-facto, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or first cousin.
7. The Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to:
 - (a) verify the validity of entries and entrants (including entrants' identity, eligibility, age and place of residence);
 - (b) disqualify any entrants for tampering with the entry process or for submitting an entry not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions; and
 - (c) remove and exclude any entry that does not meet the eligibility requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions from the Project at any time.
8. An entrant can only enter the Project once.

How to Enter

9. The Project will commence at 09:00 am on Monday, 7 October 2024 WST ("Commencement Date") and will close at 05:00 pm on Friday, 22 November 2024 WST ("Closing Date").
10. Any entry received after the Closing Date will not be accepted.
11. No responsibility is accepted for incomplete, late, lost, delayed, or misdirected entries.
12. In order to enter, entrants must:
 - (a) follow the steps on the City of Armadale website on how to enter; and
 - (b) Register your full name, email address and contact phone number

13. The entry must be the submitting participant's original work, no previously published or copyrighted material.
14. The time of entry will be the time at which the completed entry form is received by [insert recipient location of entry form]
15. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to remove and exclude any entry from the Project at any time.

Participant Selection

16. Participants of Humans of Armadale 2025 - Community Volunteers will be selected from the entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. The selection will take place by 05:00 pm on Friday, 6 December 2024 WST. The winners will be notified by email and telephone within 7 days.
17. To confirm participation, the participants will be required to respond to this email or telephone call within 7 days.
18. The Promoter reserves the right to request that the selected participants provide proof of age and or proof of identity prior to participation. Identification considered suitable for the verification is at the sole discretion of the Promoter.
19. The Promoter's decision (including any decisions as to selection of participants) is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the result.
20. It is a condition of participation that selected participants must comply with all these Terms and Conditions.

No Liability

21. All costs incurred by the participant associated with participation in this project are the responsibility of the participant.
22. All participants unconditionally and irrevocably indemnify, release and discharge the Promoter, its employees, agents and contractors from any and all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of participation in this Project including (but not limited to) loss of income, personal injury and damage to property, whether direct or consequential, foreseeable, due to some negligent act or omission or otherwise.
23. The Promoter and their associated personnel, agencies and companies will not be responsible or liable for:
 - (a) any loss or damage whatsoever or personal injury suffered or sustained, in connection with the Project, or any act or omission of the Promoter, or their respective agents, employees or contractors;
 - (b) any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries; or
 - (c) any loss or damage sustained or incurred:
 - (i) if, for any reason, the Project is suspended, varied or terminated at any time, with or without prior warning or publicity;
 - (ii) as a result of late, lost or misdirected entries.
24. These indemnities and disclaimers apply to the full extent permitted by law.

Reserved Rights

25. In all matters, all decisions of the Promoter will be final and cannot be contested. No correspondence or discussions will be entertained.
26. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

Privacy Details

27. Each entrant's consent continues until the consent is withdrawn in accordance with the applicable law. Entrants have the option to withdraw their consent and unsubscribe from receiving any communications at any time.
