ARE YOU READY TO VOTE IN THE COUNCIL ELECTIONS?

Voters enrolled on the State Electoral Roll for a residence within the City of Armadale are eligible to vote.



To check your enrolment scan the QR code, visit elections.wa.gov.au/oes or call the Western Australian Electoral Commission on 13 63 06.

The last day to enrol will be **Friday 25 August** and late enrolments will not be accepted by the Western Australian Electoral Commission.

Election packages will be posted to all eligible electors starting in late September, in plenty of time for Election Day.

The ballot papers can be returned by mail or hand delivered and placed in a sealed ballot box at the City's Administration Centre up until 6pm of Election Day. If you return your vote by post, it is best to do that early to ensure your vote can be counted on Election Day.

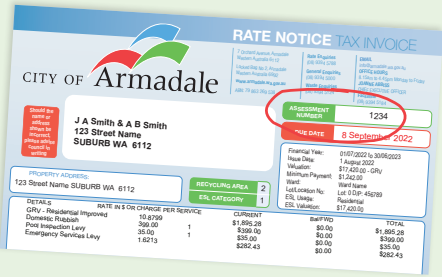
