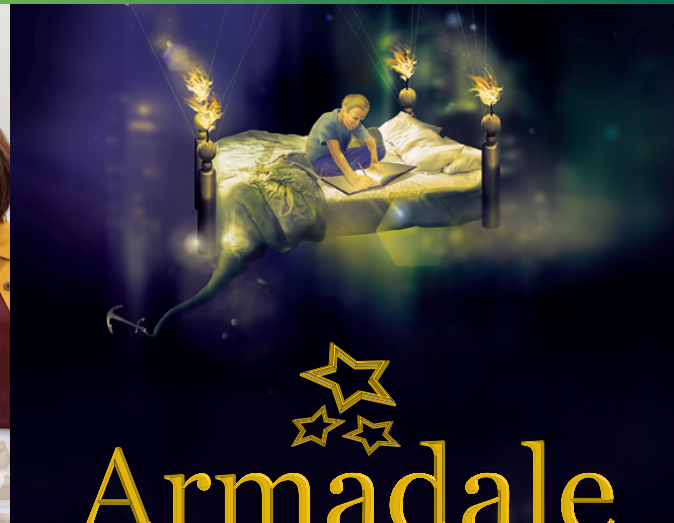

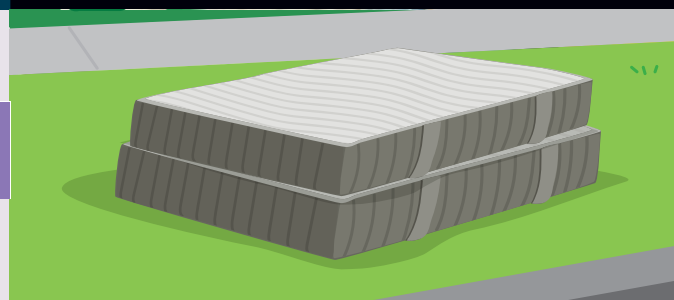


HOUSEHOLD LIGHT BULBS

The recycling hubs are located at the City's libraries, Administration Centre, Armadale Fitness & Aquatic Centre and Stockland Harrisdale.
