RESTRICTED BURNING BEGINS IN OCTOBER

A Permit to Burn must be obtained prior to lighting any fires in the open air from **1 October until 30 November** and then again from **1 April to 31 May** inclusive.

You can obtain a permit from the City's Administration office on Monday, Wednesday or Friday between the hours of 3 to 4pm or download the Application to Set Fire to Bush on Land from **armadale.wa.gov.au**

If you share your home with a four-legged friend, you may receive a notice in the post advising your pet registration is due to be renewed by 31 October.

All dogs over the age of three months, and cats from the age of six months, must be microchipped and registered with your local Council. Registrations run from 1 November and expire on 31 October every year.
