Street Tree Planting Request

Street trees play an important role in the community! Trees reduce ambient air temperature and 'urban heat island' effect. Street trees improve the visual amenity of the streetscape, create more liveable communities, safer walking environments and provide food and habitat for wildlife! In the interest of beautifying our streets, the City will plant a verge tree at the request of a resident.

Street Tree Planting Facts:

- Species The City's Arboricultural team selects the most appropriate tree species for a verge. The selection is based on local conditions, climate, neighbourhood character, street tree masterplans and relevant strategies.
- Planting Street tree planting is scheduled to occur between late autumn and spring, when there is good opportunity for successful tree establishment.
- Weather Street tree planting may be delayed by weather or other unforseen events. Due to this, the City is unable to provide an exact planting date.
- Requests and Orders Street tree requests are required to be submitted by November 30 to be considered for planting the following calendar year.
