

Street and Road Names

The City is responsible for submitting applications for street and road names to the Landgates Geographical Names Committee for Approval.

If subdivision occurs, or the City is made aware of naming or numbering inconsistencies, we will review the site and may issue an address clarification to the current owner(s).

New road names can be proposed by any party. An application will require the support of the City before it is submitted to Landgate for approval.

Landgate then assesses the application on behalf of the Minister for Lands.

Application Submission

An application for Street and Road names is to include:

- Contact details of applicant or developer;
- Development Site Details;
- Proposed Street / Road names (which have passed the preliminary validation of GNC);
- Plan showing the full extent of the proposed road;
- Details of the origin of the street / road name and the source of the information.
