Services Description

DADAA will be hosting the DADAA Accessible Viewing Area within this accessible and inclusive event.

New technology can help you enjoy the concert in a fuller, richer way:

Audio Description

For people who are blind or vision-impaired.

Hear a professional live narration of the event, in real time, similar to an audio book.

To access the Audio Description service, please download the Sennheiser MobileConnect App on your smart device prior to attending the event and connect to the 'DADAA Mobileconnect' network at the event. Please bring your own earphones.

Braille songbooks

For people who are blind or vision-impaired

Assistive Listening

For people who are hard-of-hearing

Hear the audio direct into your Bluetooth-compatible hearing aid.

To access the assistive listening service, please download the Sennheiser MobileConnect App on your smart device prior to attending the event and connect to the 'DADAA Mobileconnect' network at the event. Please approach a DADAA staff who will assist you at the event.

Auslan interpreter

For people who use sign language

An Auslan interpreter will be present for the duration of the stage program. We recommend arriving early to secure a spot at the front of general admission, or for a guaranteed clear view of the interpreter book a spot in the Accessible Viewing Area.

Accessible Viewing Area

For all people with mobility or seating requirements including walkers & wheelchairs. Choose from a picnic spot on grassed terraces or book a chair/table space on a flat surface.

Accessible Toilets

Ambulant toilets (temporary portaloos) are located at the north end, against the Armadale Shopping Centre wall. A fully accessible toilet is permanently located on the north-east side of the park, on the footpath towards Orchard Avenue. There are also permanent toilets within the shopping centre.

ACROD Parking

For all holders of ACROD parking permits.

Undercover public parking at Armadale Central Shopping Centre (Enter carpark near Red Rooster, open all afternoon, carpark closes 10pm)

Overflow ACROD parking directly across the road (Enter carpark between 5 – 6.45pm via Jull Street. If all ACROD marked bays are full you may use multiple unmarked bays as necessary. Please show your permit to staff at the gate.)

Livestream

Can't make it in person? You don't need to miss out. For those not able or not comfortable attending the event, you are invited to join the accessible livestream. Tune in on your device or Smart TV on the City of Armadale YouTube Channel (<https://www.youtube.com/cityofarmadale>).

Christmas Parade

Please note the Parade does not include the services listed above.

The Parade starts at Jull Street Mall at the Armadale Train Station end, heads down Jull Street Mall and onto Jull Street, turns left onto Orchard Avenue and finishes at Memorial Park. Viewing areas are available on both sides of most of the parade route.

The Parade and viewing areas are on flat, level paved ground. The only slope is on Orchard Avenue (at the end of parade).

Note entertainment at the Parade includes a loud percussion group and amplified music throughout. Disposable ear plugs are available at the City of Armadale Info Tent on Memorial Park.
