Summer Scavenger Hunt

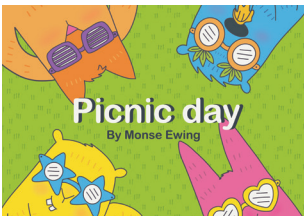
6 - 31 January, during library opening hours

Suitable for school aged children.

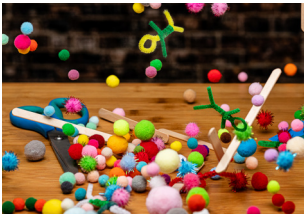


Picnic Day
