Many plants are indicators of seasonal change and a source of food and medicine, as well as material needed in the construction of shelters and the production of weapons and tools.

Join members of the Wildflower Society when they present the second in this series of talks about wildflowers that bloom during each of the six Noongar seasons.

This particular presentation will cover the season of **Kamberang** which falls during the months of October and November.

This is when our local bushland is still flushed with beautiful wild flowers. Temperatures are beginning to rise which sees the winter inundated damp lands drying out as the water recedes, and the arrival of masses of small colourfully flowered ephemeral plants. It is during this season when the Balga and Bull Banksia start flowering and the fruit of the Quandong begin to ripen as do the native cranberries.
