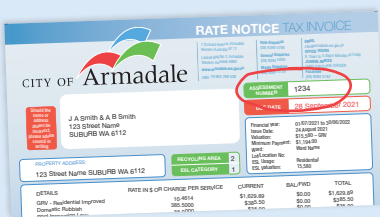

## 2022/23 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS
