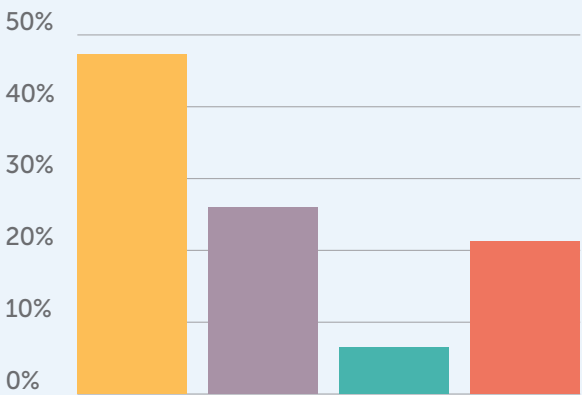
SOCIAL PRIORITIES

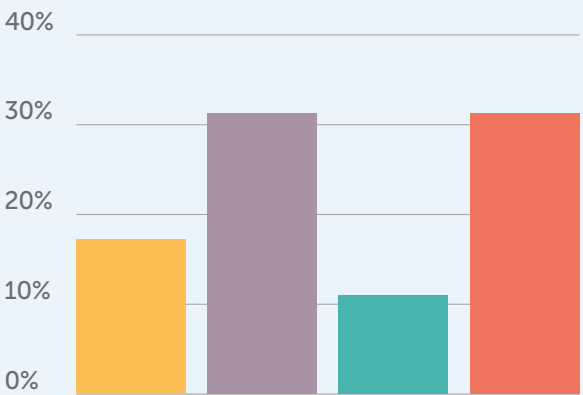
Mount Nasura

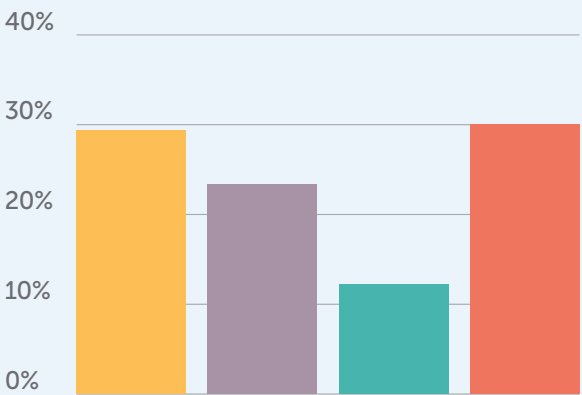
