Armadale Road duplication upgrade

Construction of the Armadale Road duplication will begin in March.

The works are designed to reduce traffic congestion and improve freeway access.

The dualling will include the section from Anstey Road (east), to Tapper Road (west). The completion of this section of dualling will be immediately followed by a new link to the Kwinana Freeway, where Armadale Road will be linked to North Lake Road in Cockburn Central, with direct access to the freeway. The project will also see Nicholson Road grade separated, with a roundabout installed at ground level. Armadale Road traffic will travel over an elevated overpass at Nicholson Road, with a roundabout installed at ground level.

The project has been made possible through the City's ongoing advocacy strategy, attracting \$382 million funding from the Federal and State Government.

Rangers working harder to find homes

Make microchipping and updating your details for your furry best friend a New Year's resolution, to ensure your dog is home quicker if it goes wandering.

All dogs found will now be checked for microchips with portable scanners before being impounded. Designed to reduce the number of dogs impounded and get them home to their owner sooner, the improved process follows the City's vision for prevention over prosecution.

Residents are reminded to register and microchip their dog, as well as attach an identification disk to ensure the quick return of your furry friend should he or she escape.
