## **City of Armadale**

## Notice of Proposed Cat Local Law

The City of Armadale proposes to make the Cat Local Law.

The **purpose** of the proposed local law is to encourage responsible cat ownership and provide a means to address issues related to nuisance cats and cats in environmentally sensitive areas; and

The **effect** of this local law will permit the City to regulate cat ownership within the district, with particular regard to –

- Cats that cause a nuisance, in a public place;
- Cats that cause a nuisance on private property;
- Land in the district on which cats are prohibited absolutely;
- Limiting the numbers of cats that may be kept without a permit from the local government;
- Impounding of cats; and
- Offences under, and enforcement of, the local law.
